✗ No, he/she/it isn't.

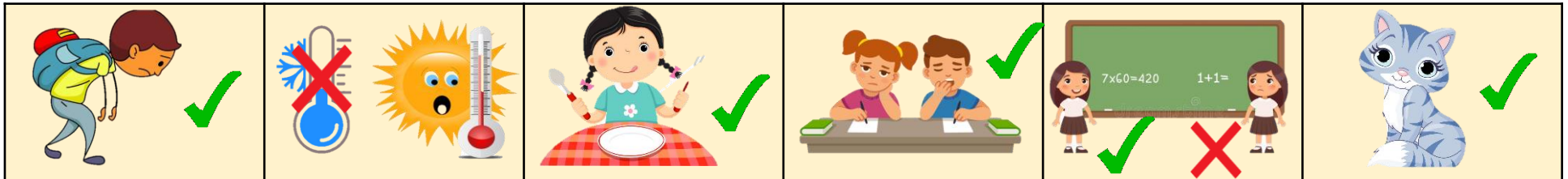
